

# Emergency regulations:

Information especially for state agencies

An emergency regulation is:

--Promulgated if there is an "emergency situation" or regulation must be promulgated within 280 days.

--Effective upon filing with the Registrar of Regulations.

--Effective for up to one year, and this period may be extended up to 6 months if the Governor approves.

--Usually replaced with a permanent regulation; therefore, a Notice of Intended Regulatory Action (NOIRA) to promulgate the permanent replacement regulation is often filed at the same time as the emergency regulation.
